OBSERVATIONS:

- ✓ In order to keep up with changing technology, the faculty believed that new UG and PG programs needed to be introduced.
- ✓ It is recommended that the infrastructure of the computer lab be expanded to allow students from all disciplines to use it for longer hours.

ACTION TAKEN:

- ✓ New programs have been introduced in the undergraduate (UG) stream. Computer lab facilities extended.

These suggestions were communicated to the Governing Body.

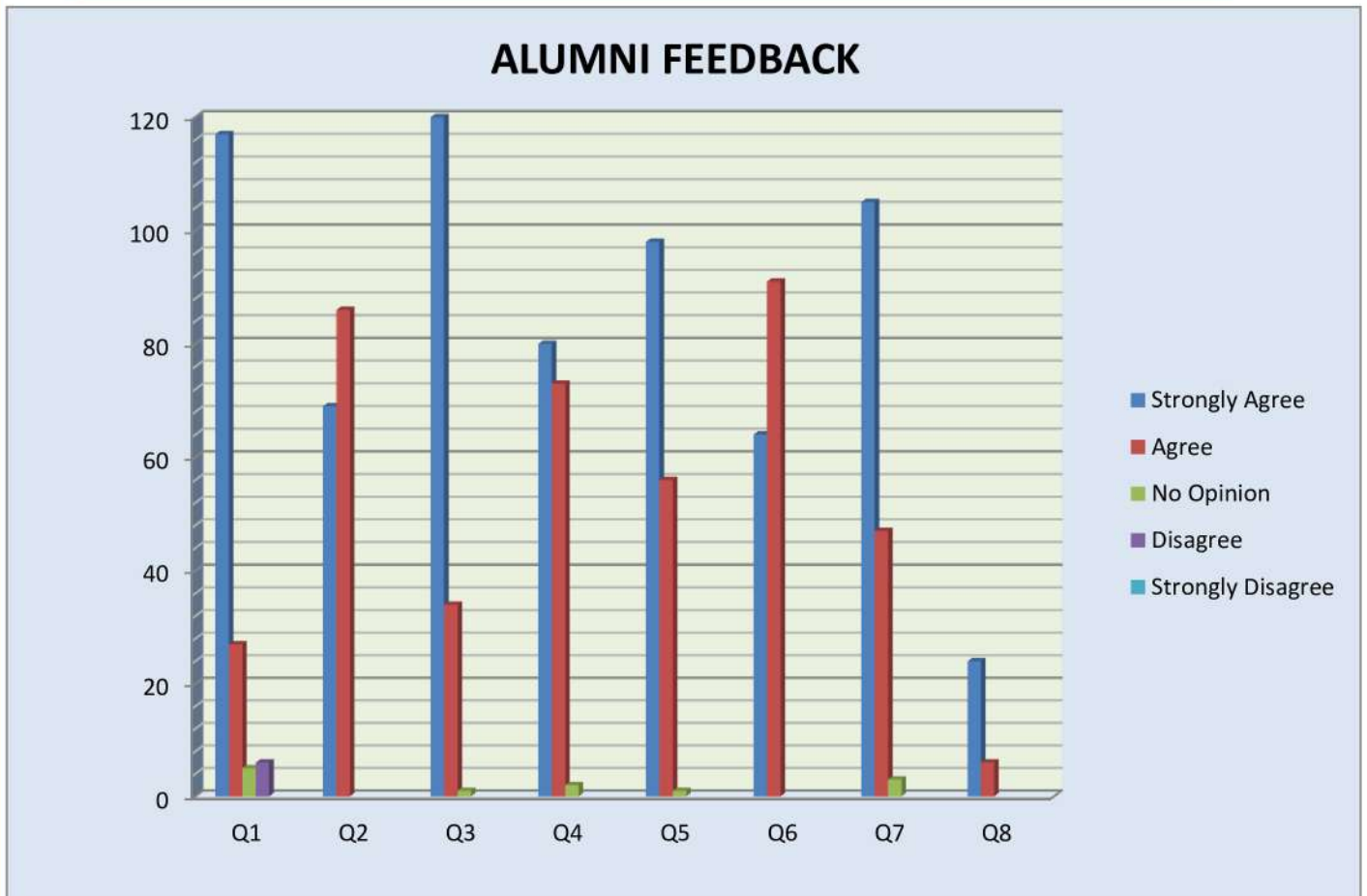


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2022-2023 ACADEMIC YEAR - ALUMNI FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM
