

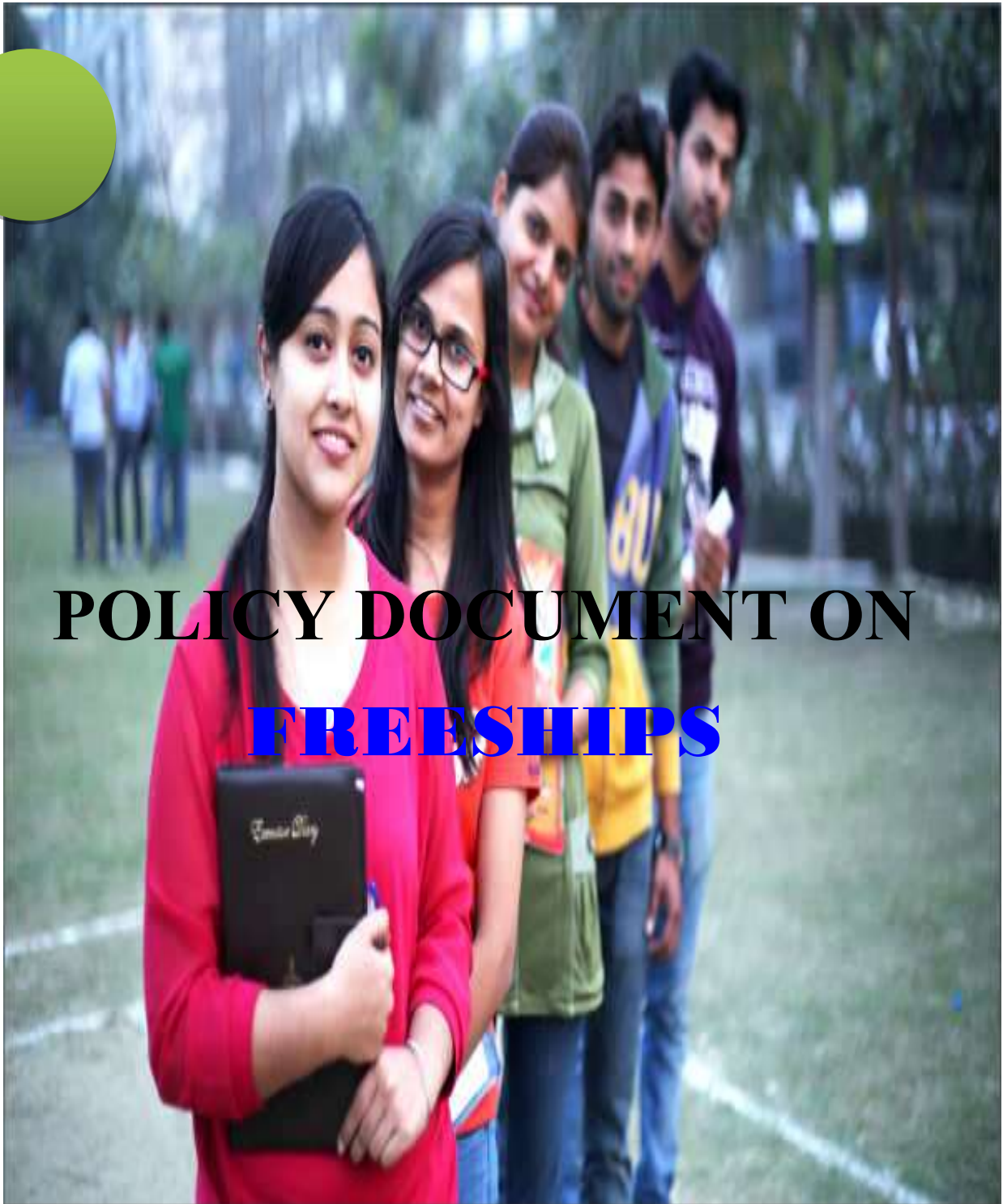

POLICY DOCUMENT ON **FRESHSHIPS**

ANR College is an independent college that has been acknowledged by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under sections 2F and 12B. The college adheres to all the relevant norms and regulations in order to provide government scholarships to all students. In addition, the college offers a range of scholarships, fellowships, and incentives to students based on their academic, cultural, social, and sporting achievements at both national and international levels. The following information outlines all the scholarships offered by the college.

1. The College is offering a reduction in fees for students who are in financial need or who are the children of teaching and non-teaching staff, across all courses.

A standard procedure is followed for the same

- The students who are intending to avail this opportunity have to submit their application in a prescribed format to the principal of the college. The application can be collected from the administration office.
 - The Principal scrutinizes the application based on the applicant's academic performance and economic background and is forwarded to the Secretary and Correspondent.
 - The Secretary and Correspondent presents the same in the management council meeting and the final approval or rejection of the same happens.
 - Submission of application happens in the month of March for existing students and at the time of enrolment for first year students.
2. The college is also providing medals for the academically excellent students from all the programmes and courses. Controller of Examinations provides the data of the students and the students are awarded with medal from each programme.
 3. To further strengthen the culture of sports and fitness, the college is also providing freeships to the students who achieve medals at state, national or international level.

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Terms and Conditions:

- All students must assure frequent practice, seek expert advice, and participate in coaching camps to maintain and enhance their standards and performance.
- The scholarship granted is valid for a duration of one year and can be extended annually, subject to the condition that the recipients enhance or sustain their skill level in the respective sport.
- The scholarship may be revoked if the student is discovered to be engaged in any form of misconduct (either on or off campus), fails to pass their academic evaluations, or fails to meet any other academic requirements outlined in the university student bulletin.
- The Scholarship is exclusively applicable to the Tuition fee and does not extend to any other expenses such as Admission fee, Examination fee, Transport fee, Hostel Fee, or any other fees that may arise periodically.
- The award Committee retains the authority to adjust, decrease, approve, or reject the award amount.
- College also encourages students to seek for and apply for a wide range of scholarships and grants offered by the government and other organisations.
- A staff member is responsible for managing the scholarships and freeships offered by the government and other organisations.
- The office staff will notify the department heads about the scholarships and tuition waivers.
- The Heads of Departments will notify the class mentors of each batch to inform the students.
- The students will visit the relevant department at the office to obtain further information regarding the scholarships.
- The scholarship and freeship administrators will provide additional information about the scholarships and gather the required information from the students.
- If a student breaches any other provision of the scholarship/freeship, it may be promptly stopped or revoked without additional notification.
