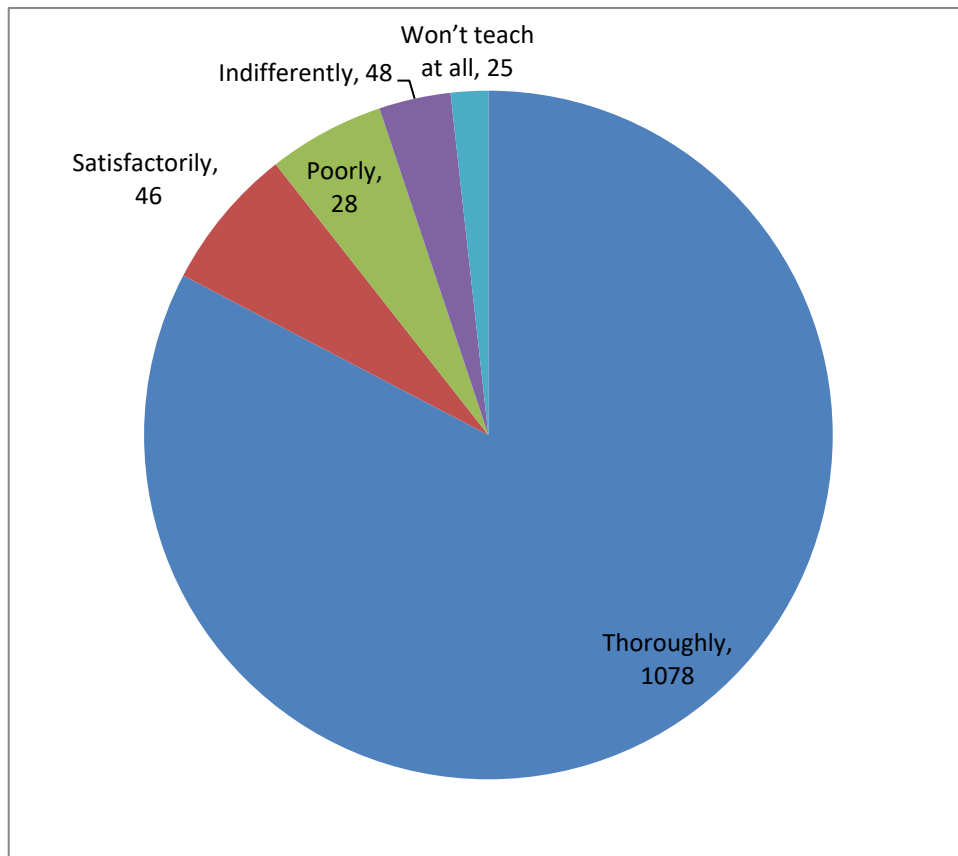

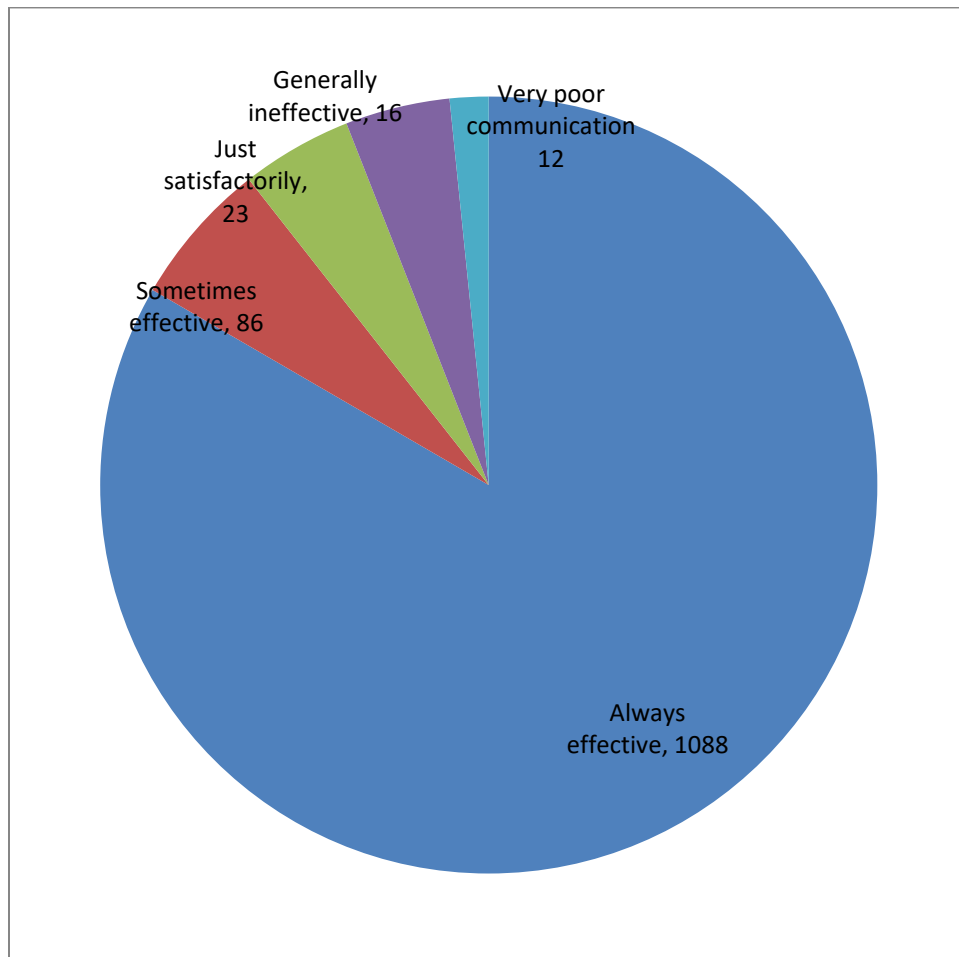

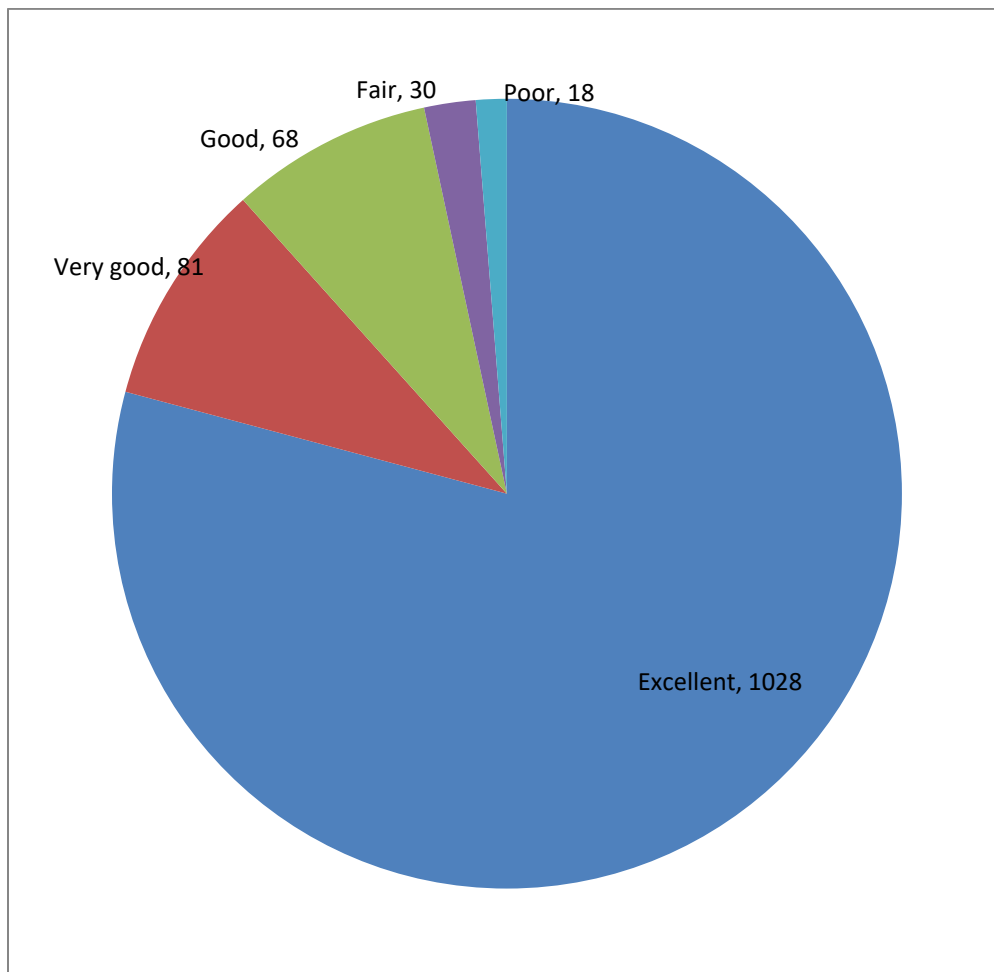
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

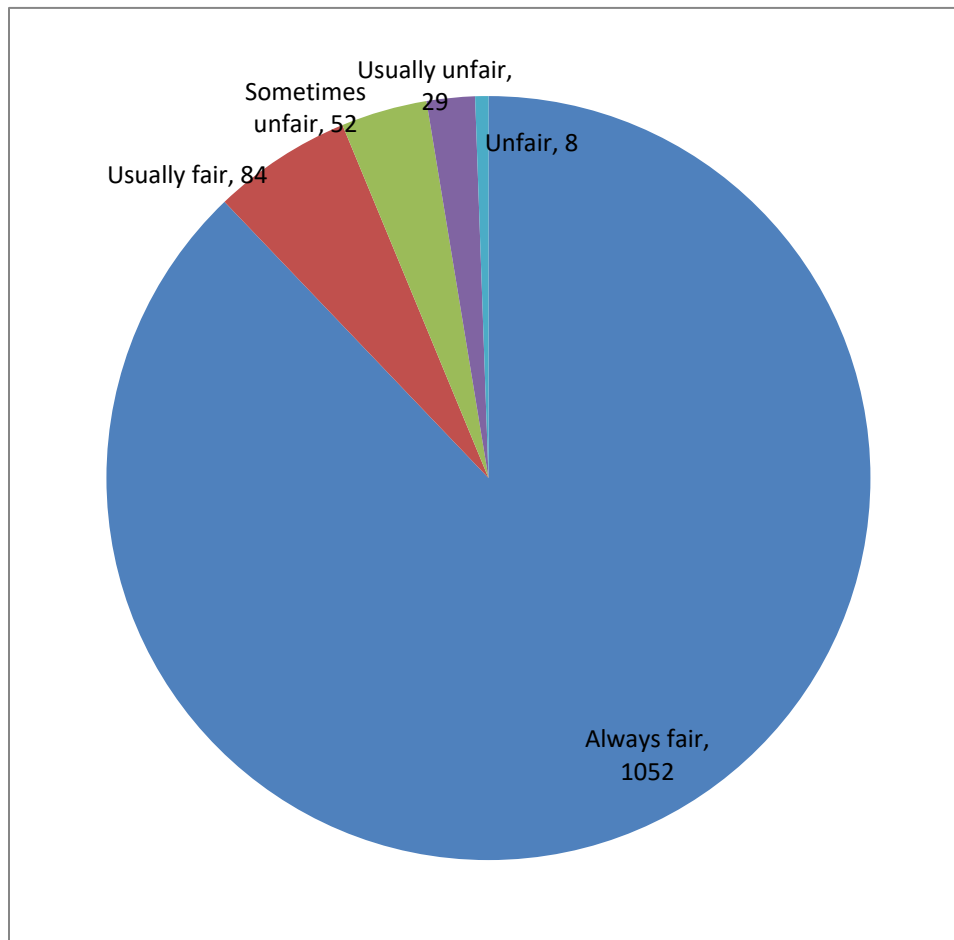
4. The Teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

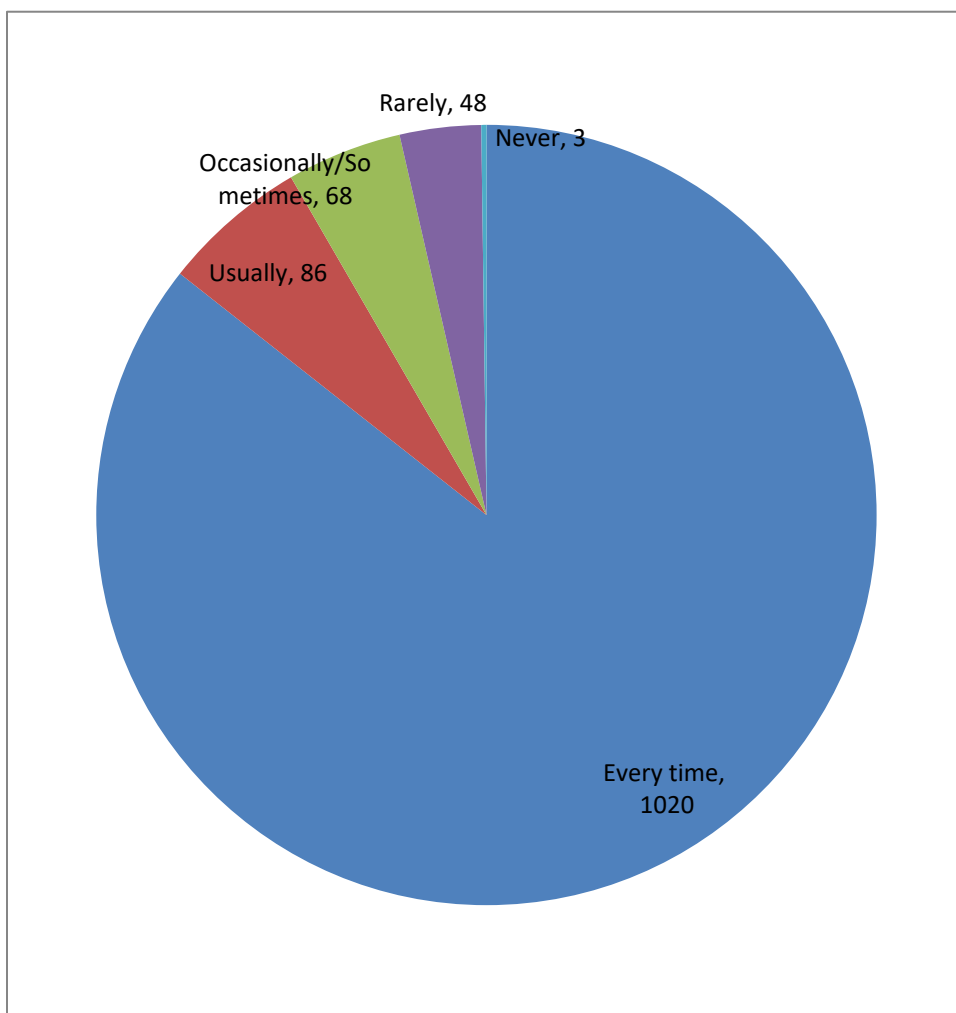

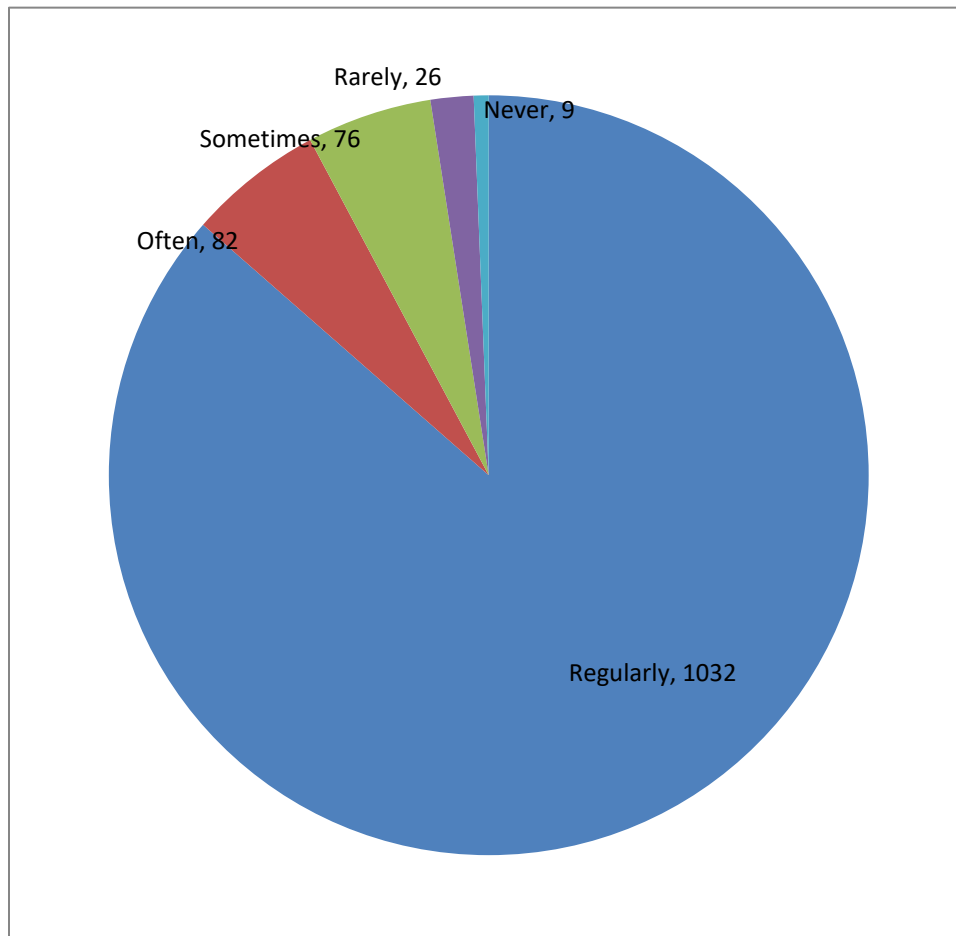
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

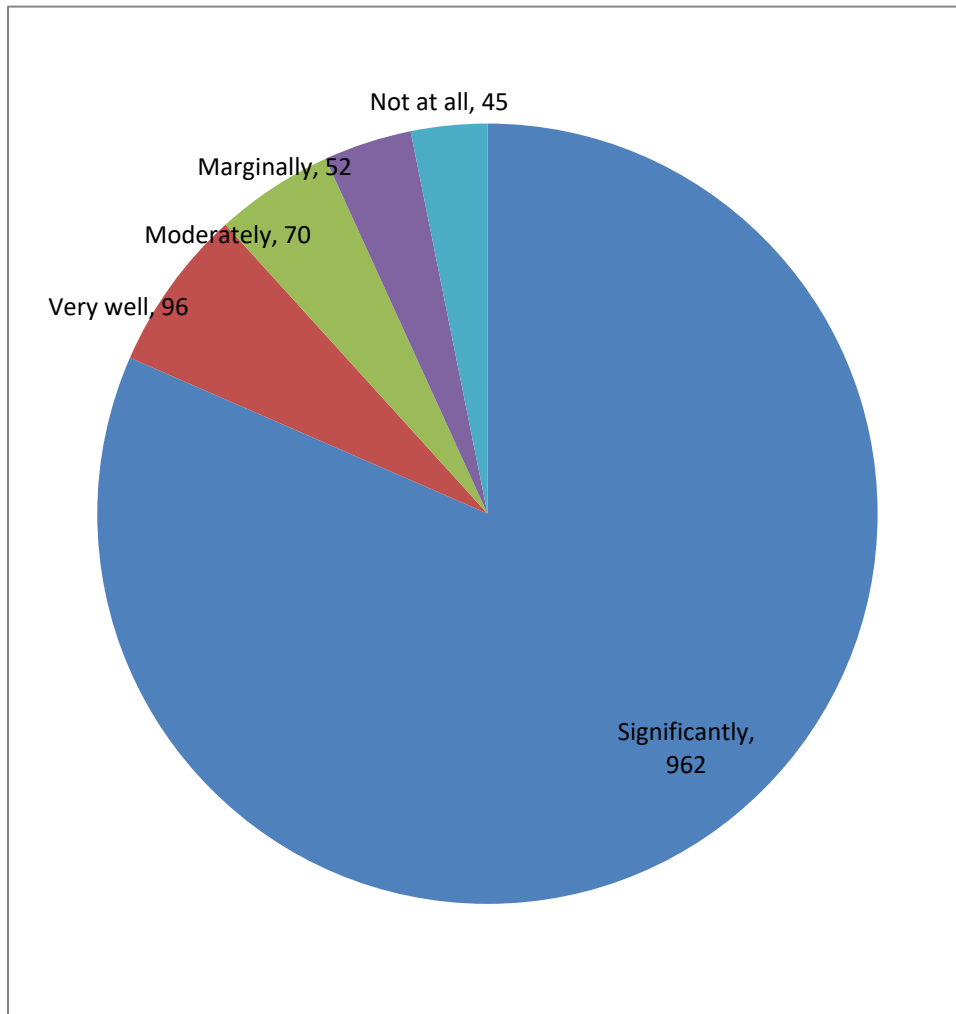

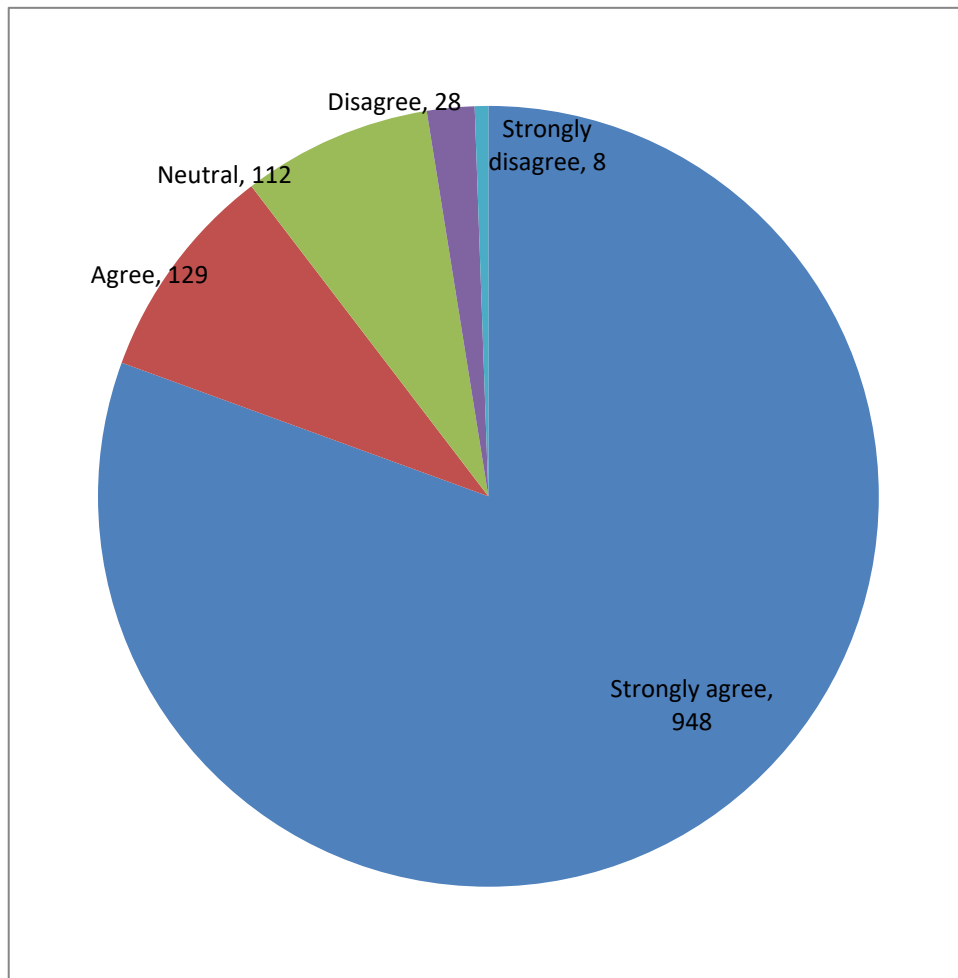
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitate you in cognitive, social and emotional growth

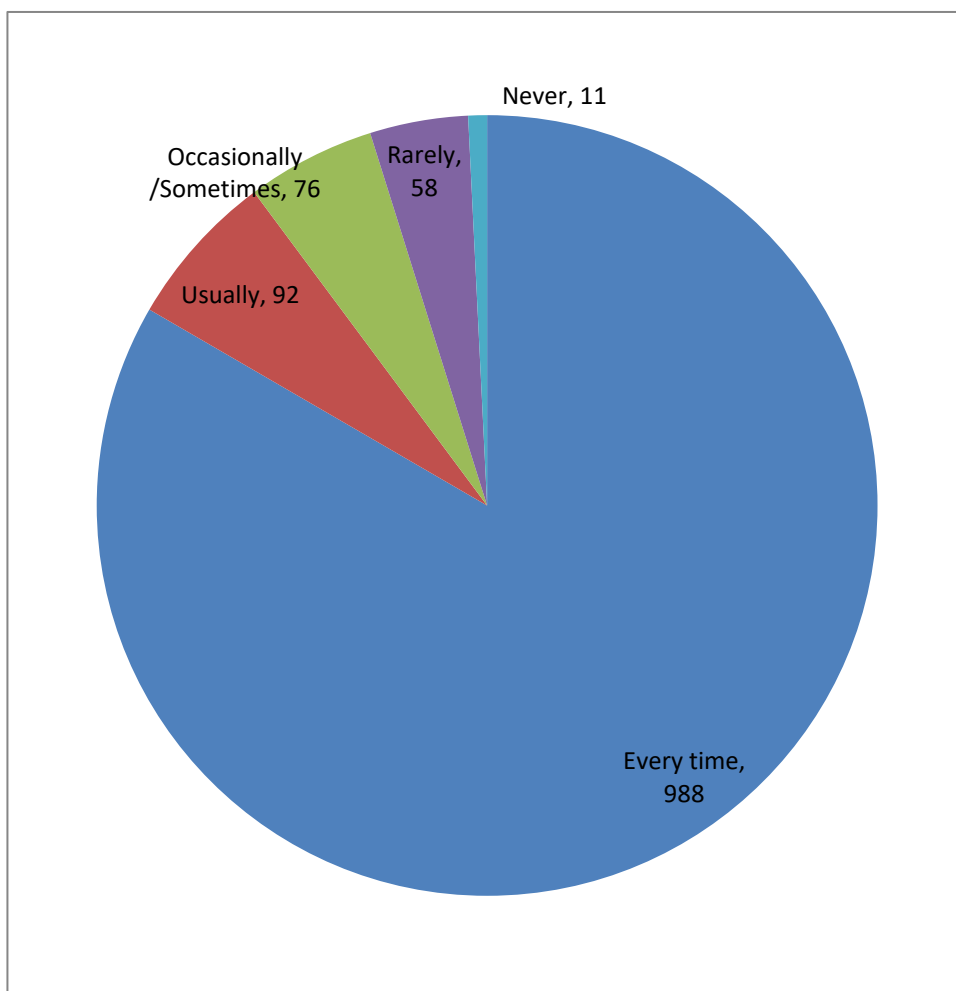
9. The institution is providing multiple opportunities to learn and grow

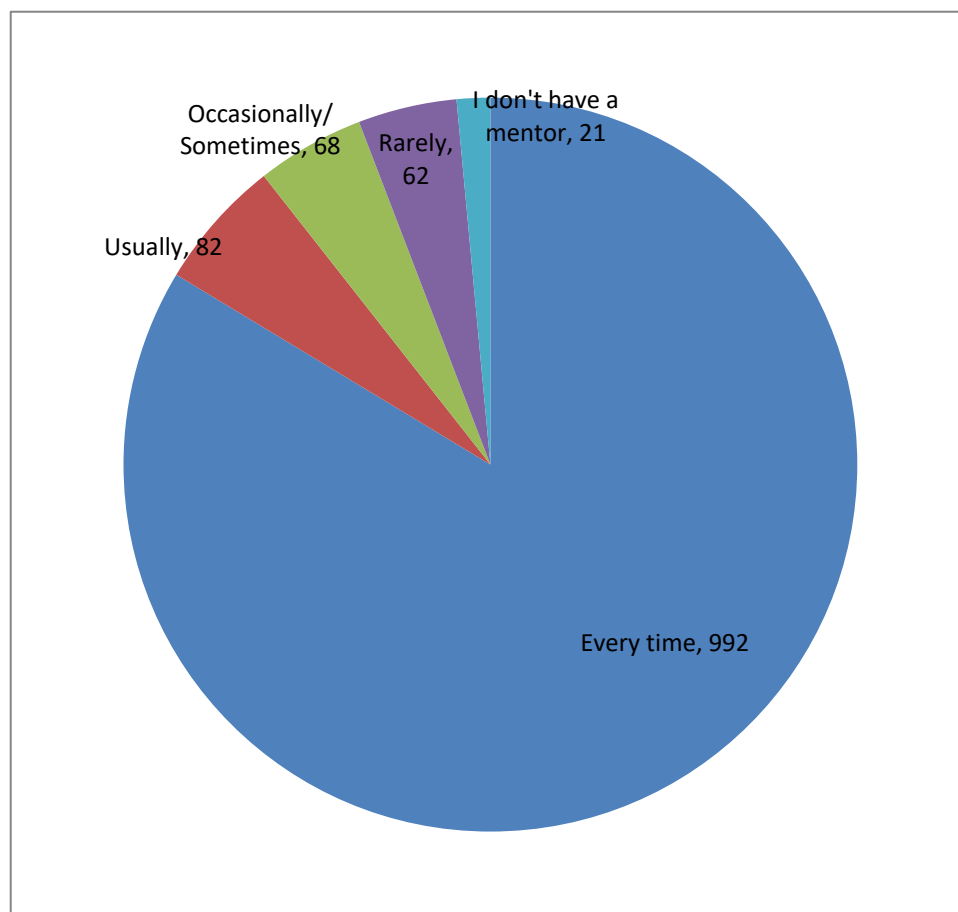
10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes

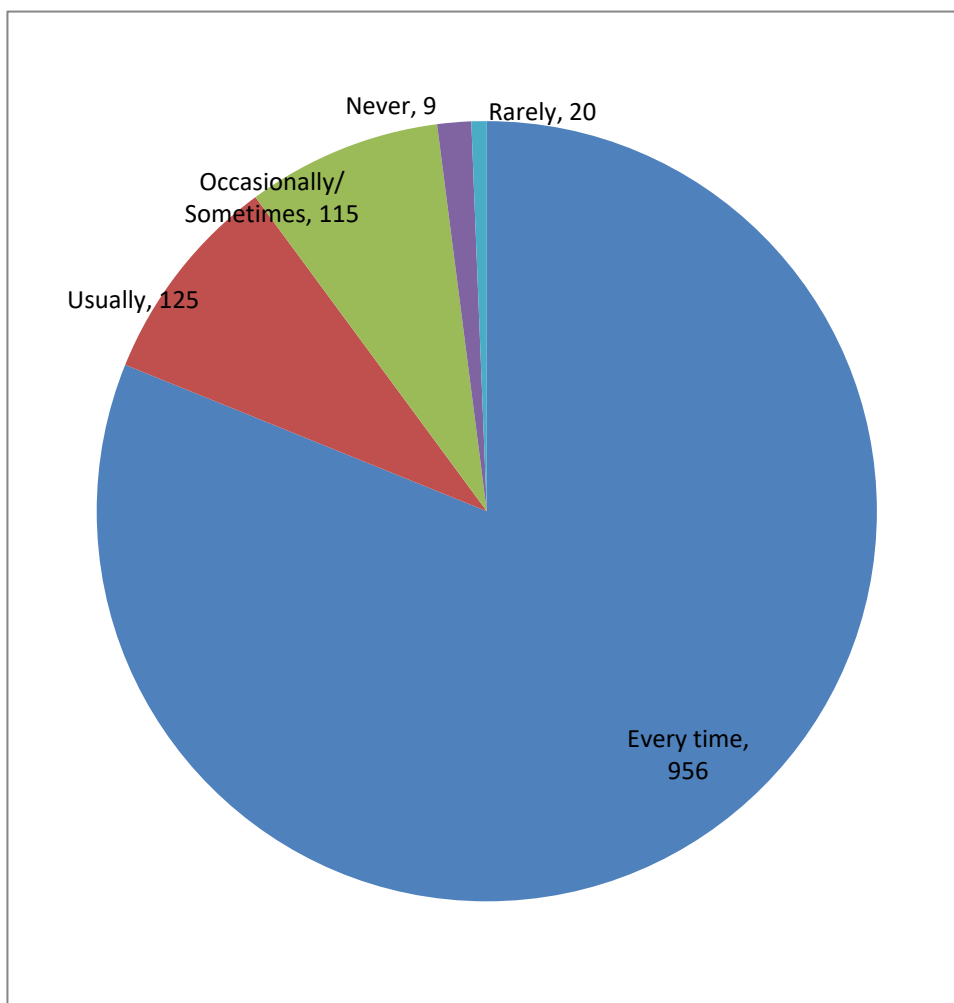
11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

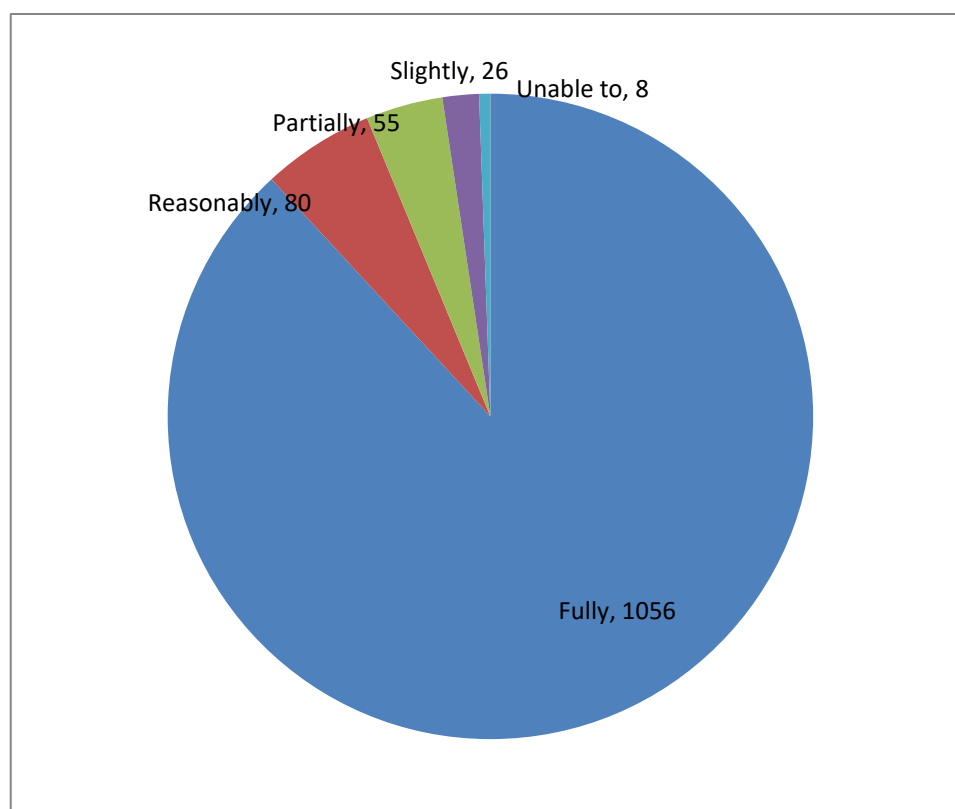
12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications

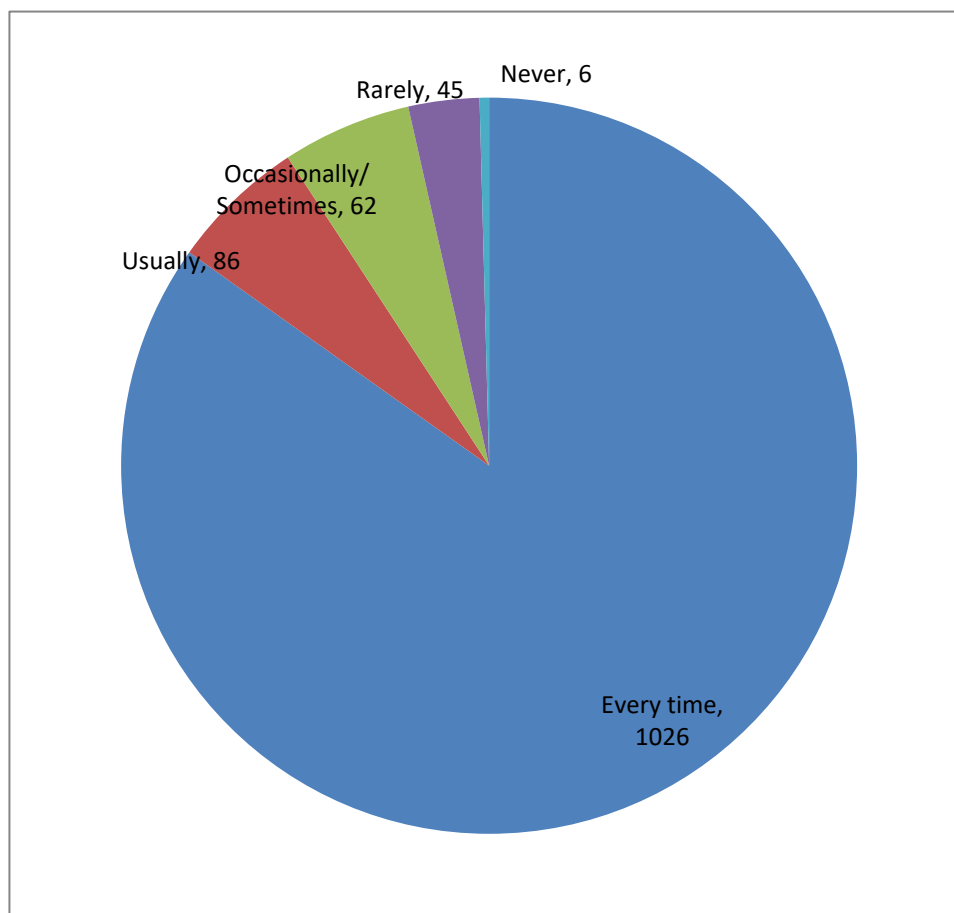
13. The teachers identifying your strengths and encouraging you by providing right level of challenges

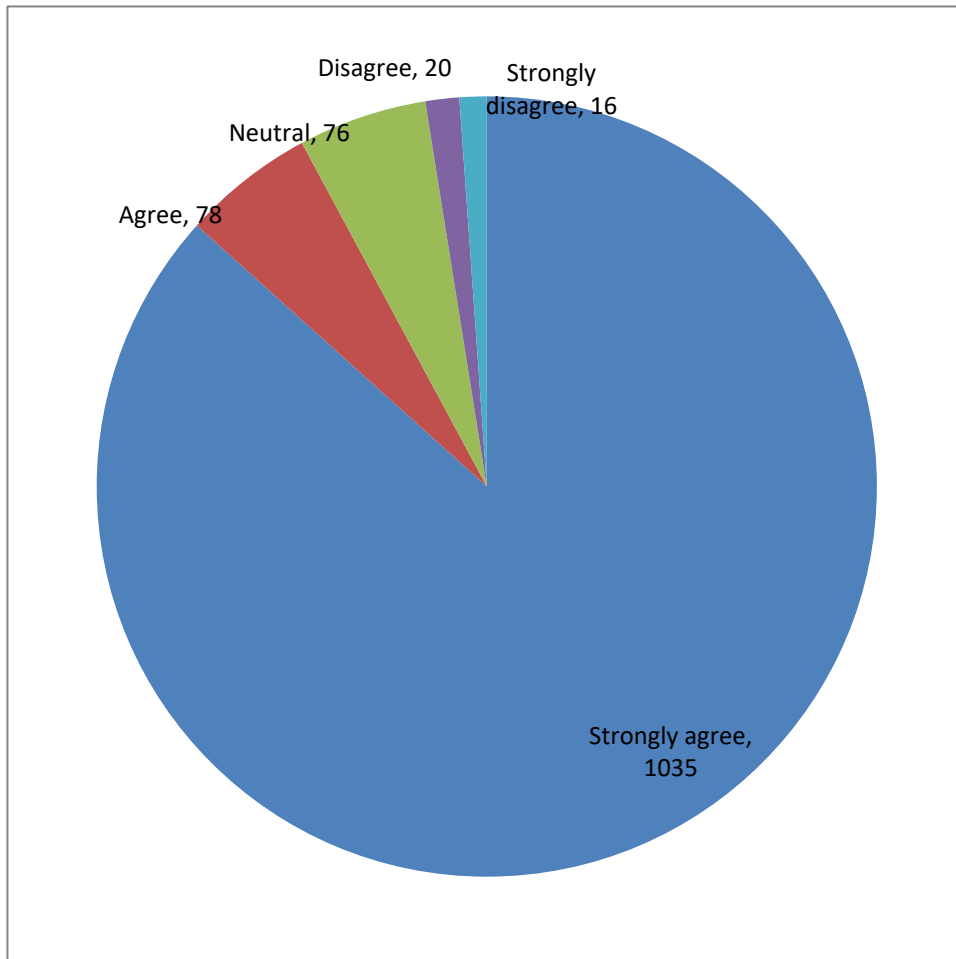
14. The teachers identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them

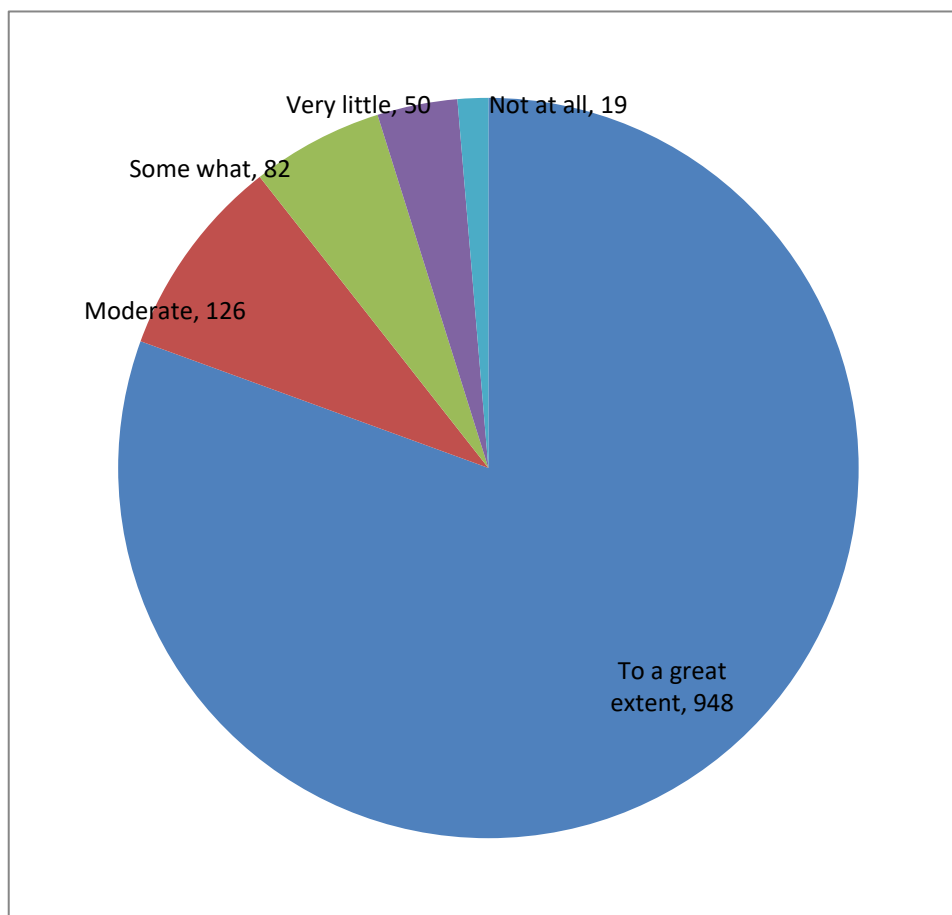
15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process

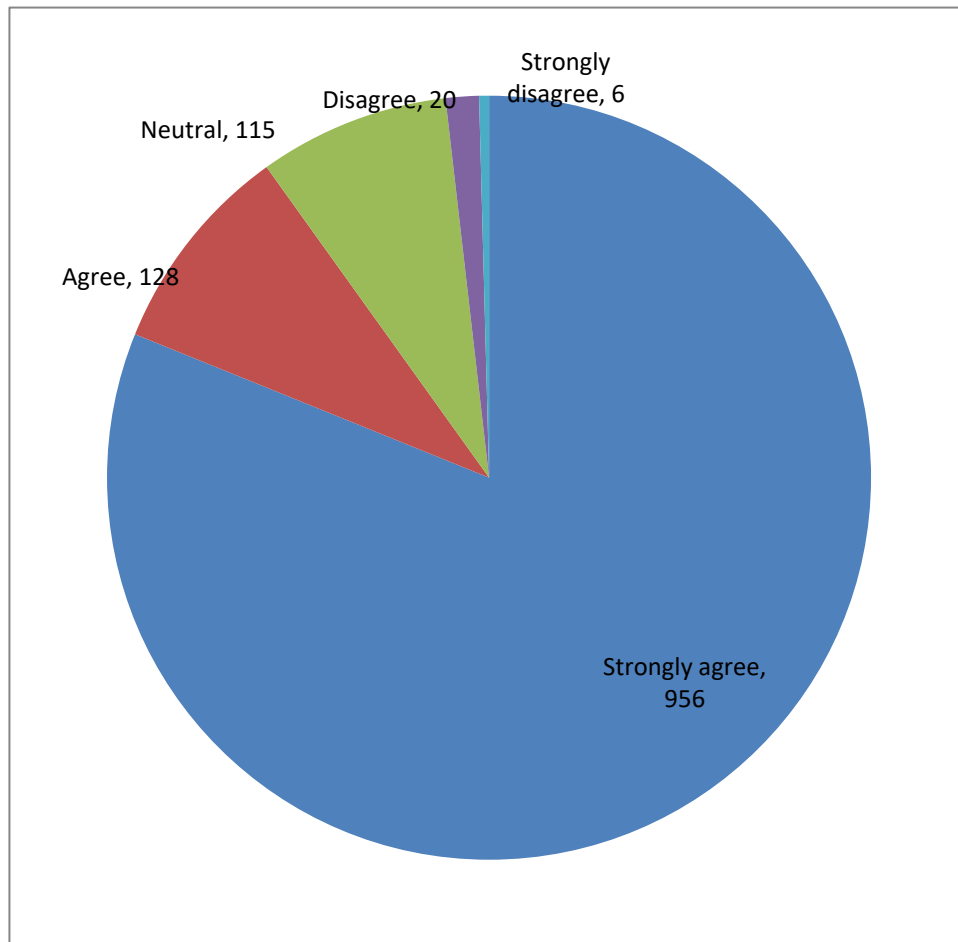

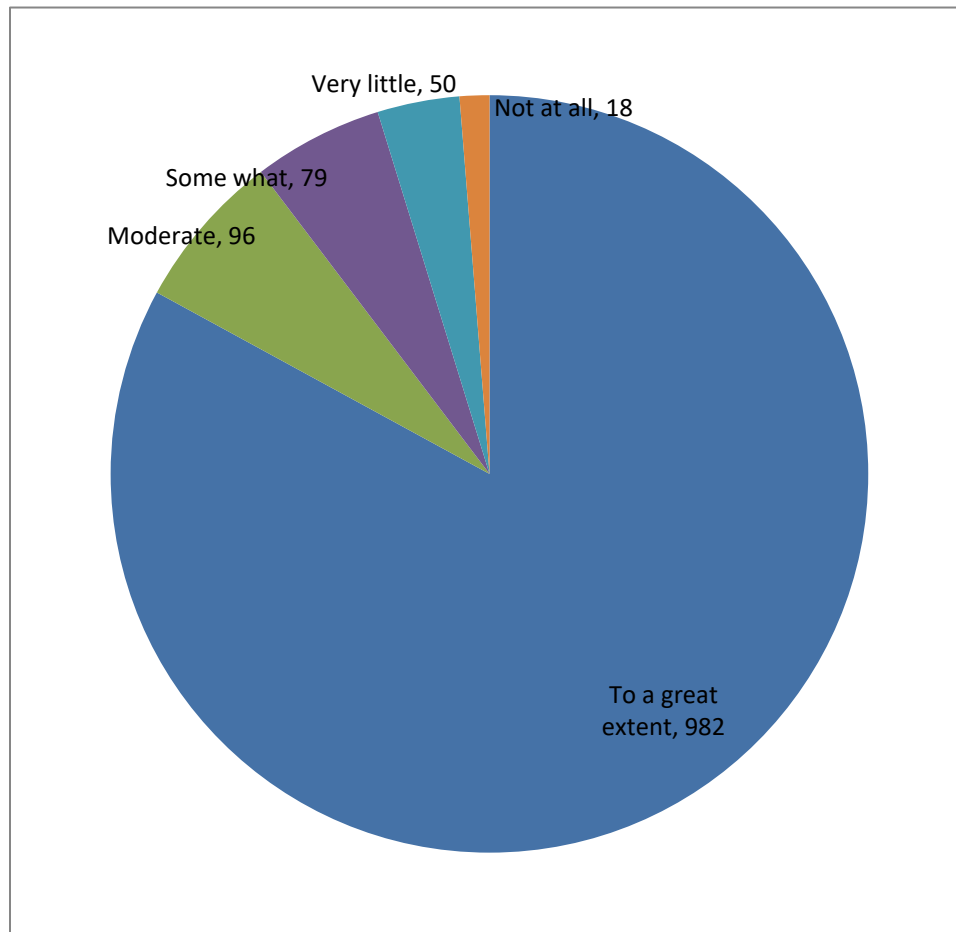
17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities

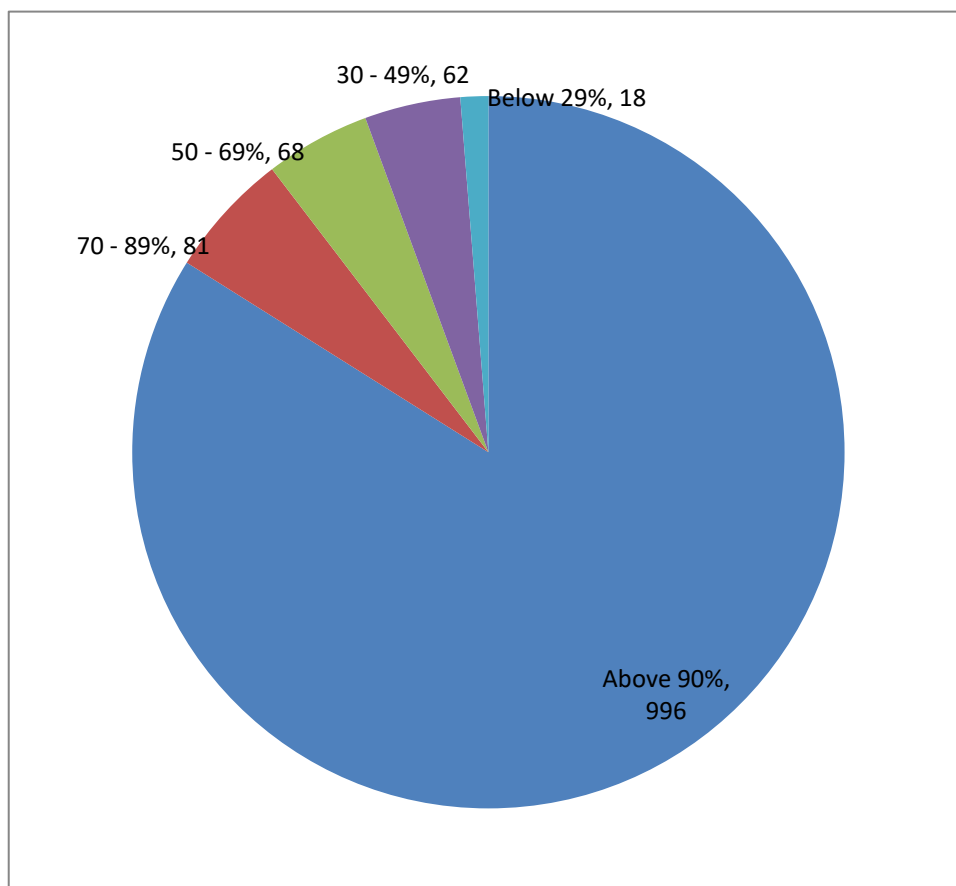
18. The efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work
